

LULLINGSTONE WAR MEMORIAL



Servicemen killed in the First World War are commemorated on a wooden panel, inscribed with gold lettering, on the front of the memorial prayer desk in St. Botolph's Church.

This prayer desk was dedicated in 1948.

The first three named died in the First World War -
John Percival Baker, buried in Belgium
Brothers Henry Treneman and John Ernest Partridge – Henry was buried in Cairo and John in Poland.
